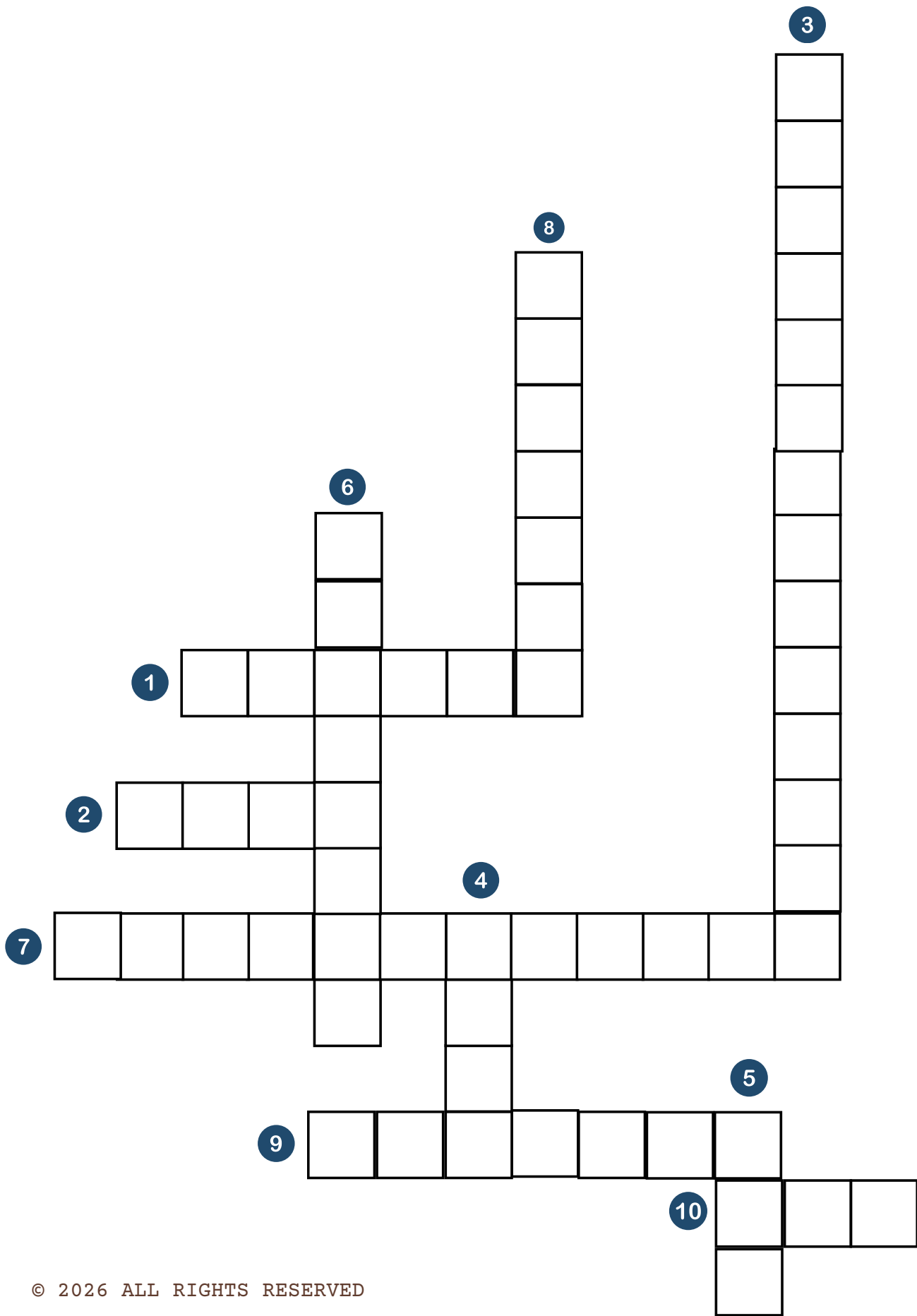




# THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION
